



**TAQSIMA ĊENTRALI TAL-VIŻA**  
**CENTRAL VISA UNIT**

**DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR WORKING HOLIDAY VISA**

- 01 Visa Application Form:** This must be **fully** filled and signed by the applicant;;
- 02 Passport** - Must have a validity of which shall exceed ninety (90) days beyond the initial expected period of stay in Malta;
- 03 1 Passport photo:** according to ICAO Standards Pg14 (3.9.1.5);
- 04 A Police history criminal clearance report** from your state/territory of residence;
- 05 Bank statement** demonstrating that you have sufficient funds to provide for your initial stay in Malta;
- 06 Flight ticket details:** with return ticket, or sufficient funds to purchase the return ticket. Full flight itinerary must be provided, clearly indicating applicant's name, date of flight, and all stops - preferably transiting outside the Schengen area;
- 07 Medical and Travel insurance:**
  - Must be valid for the Schengen area;
  - Health insurance policy with a minimum coverage limit of €100,000, providing medical treatment including hospitalisation coverage in Malta and, if necessary, in other European countries for each dependent. The health insurance is to be presented then during the biometric appointment. The insurance policy must have a validity covering the entire period of stay in Malta and must be valid from the point of entry in the Schengen area;
  - Must include name, surname, and passport number;
  - If the insurance policy does not display this information on the certificate of insurance, the table of benefits will be required.
- 08 Visa fee waived** - this is without prejudice to service fees levied by the External Service Provider;

- \* **Applications must be lodged no less than 6 weeks prior to the intended entry into Malta.**
- \* **All documents must be submitted in English. Any documents requiring translation must be ordered from the approved list of authorised translators, accessed through the following link:**

- \* **It must be ensured that email addresses are correctly written when submitting the visa application as official communication will be communicated via email. Identità will not be responsible for communication not reaching applicants because of mistakes in email addresses.**
