SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

The original version of all documents submitted with this application must be presented at the time of the biometrics appointment.

Documents submitted must be in line with the latest published Policy by Identità, establishing the standards for the recognition of foreign public documents.

- ☐ Copy of proof of sufficient means example, copy of pension/secure bonds/ document issued from the Commissioner for Revenue(CFR)/ bank statements which amount to at least the minimum means which determine the grant of social assistance to Maltese nationals;
- ☐ Copy of the comprehensive health insurance or S1 certificate issued by the country of origin or the Entitlement Certificate if the applicant is already in hold of the said certificate
- ☐ Only applicants who are receiving Maltese Government Pension are not required to provide comprehensive health insurance

- ☐ Those in possession of authorisation to reside in Malta on the basis of the scheme by the Commissioner of Revenue including the Malta Permanent Residence or Retirement Programme, the applicant would need to provide, copy of the document issued from the Commissioner for Revenue (CFR), along with the comprehensive health insurance or S1 certificate issued by the country of origin or the Entitlement Certificate if the applicant is already in hold of the said certificate
- ☐ Those in possession of providing services, not in the form of employment, with a Host entity (such as, a Voluntary Organisation, Internship company), will need to provide an alternative document to that attesting to their sufficient means. A document from the Host entity confirming the purpose of residence, the duration of stay and place of residence. Such document must confirm that such entity will be ensuring that the EU national does not become a burden on the State, and that all financial needs of the EU national, and of their family members who are joining and accompanying them in Malta, along with the comprehensive health insurance or S1 certificate issued by the country of origin or the Entitlement Certificate if the applicant is already in hold of the said certificate

Kindly note that applicants in hold of a valid or expired residence card shall return their residence card upon biometric appointment. If your residence card is lost, a Police Lost Report issued here in Malta needs to be presented upon appointment.

**NOTE: Original documents must be presented upon appointment and will be returned to the applicant;
Copies must be uploaded on the online portal together with the application form;
The Department reserves the right to request any other additional document to process the application.**

NOTES TO APPLICANTS

- 01** EU and EEA and their family members who have been residing in Malta for more than 3 months should apply immediately for a registration certificate/residence card. This documentation is issued pursuant to the provisions of Directive 2004/38/EC as implemented in Maltese legislation by means of Subsidiary legislation 460.17. For this purpose they are required to submit an application for residence documentation.
 - 02** Swiss nationals and their family members, who have been residing in Malta for more than 3 months, should apply immediately for a residence permit. For this purpose they are also required to submit an application for residence documentation.

- 03** Only one application for residence permit for a specific purpose of stay may be considered at any one time.
 - 04** All required documents should be enclosed with an application. English translation of documents is required, if applicable. All photocopies are to be provided by the applicant.
 - 05** Applications in respect of minors, that is, persons who are still under 18 years of age, are to be submitted and signed by the parent/s or a person who has guardianship of the child. The relative documentation attesting the said authority over the child would have to be submitted.
 - 06** Persons concerned are being reminded that, without prejudice to any legal action that may be taken against them if false information is deliberately given, this would lead to the rejection of the application.
 - 07** Application fee, if applicable, is to be paid in full upon application and is not refundable.

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
